Canadian Navigable Waters Act

The Atlantic Salmon Federation, on behalf of the Working Group on Smallmouth Bass Eradication in the Miramichi hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Navigable Waters Registry pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for public comment described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 10(1)(b) of the said Act, the Atlantic Salmon Federation on Behalf of the Working Group on Smallmouth Bass Eradication in the Miramichi has deposited with the Minister of Transport and the on-line Common Project Search Registry (http://cps.canada.ca) and under registry number 2021-204544, a description of the following work, its site, and plans:

A temporary fish migration barrier across the Southwest Miramichi River at Slate Island.
